**4TH TRANSNATIONAL PROJECT MEETING
- CHEMNITZ, GERMANY**

The Fourth Transnational Project Meeting on the Project “Web-Based Laser Safety Modules for Vocational Education / Training” was held December 19-22, 2019 in Chemnitz, Germany. It was hosted by SWA Bildungskademie GmbH.

Representatives of partner institutions from Latvia, Hungary, Bulgaria and Germany participated in the fourth Transnational Project Meeting.

During the meeting project partners reported and discussed and following key points:

1. The status of the project by Project Coordinator Prof. L. Lazov;
2. The partners University of Ruse, ECESI and RTA presented the IO 4 - Training Modules they developed;

3. Design of web-based interactive modules presented by iTStudy Hungary.
4. Summarised report on the dissemination project results presented by Veda Consult, Bulgaria.

**FORTHCOMING PROJECT ACTIVITIES**

1. The event “Train of the trainers” will be organised in Rezekne, Latvia, from 22. to 24.01.2020.
2. The English version of Modules will be uploaded to MOODLE – 15.01.2020.
3. Handbook O7 (User Manual for trainers) will be uploaded to MOODLE – 31/01/2020.
4. The modules will be translated and uploading to MOODLE in the languages of the 5 partner countries (DE, LV, BG, HU, RO) – 22.02.-22.04.2020.
5. Pilot testing of the modules – This will be pilot tested in 4 EU countries (LV, DE, BG, RO), laser operators (10 in each country) will take part in our pilot testing of the module. They will be trained in the content of each module.
6. The period of Pilot Testing of developed modules until May 13 – 14.

7. Multiplier events in Latvia, Romania, Gemany and Bulgaria will be held until June 30.
7. The next meeting will take place on 14-15.05.2020 in Hungary, hosted by iTStudy Hungary.



During the cultural program, participants in the 4th transnational meeting visited the „Zinnkammern Pöhla“ (tin chambers Pöhla) – the traditional region around Chemnitz and UNESCO World Heritage Site since 2019.
